Where Has the Year Gone???





Minutes of the Business Meeting

GMC 49ers Business Meeting July 9, 2022 Parker's Resort, Guerneville, CA

President Donna Ventura called the meeting to order at 9:36 a.m. There were no new members or guests present. Past presidents in attendance were introduced: John and Alyce Shutzbaugh, Deo Trovao, and George Banovich.



Ruth Beckman moved to accept the minutes from the last business meeting, as posted in the last newsletter. Chris Musselman seconded the motion. Carried.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Jack Christensen reported that our account balance is \$3,693.42. Supplement to the November Anniversary rally was discussed. The club may increase the supplement to \$1700, depending on catering and venue costs. Ruth Beckman moved to accept the Treasurer's report, seconded by Garen McCune. Carried.

Vice President: Nick Roenick proposed that the membership consider increasing the annual dues by \$10. Venue prices for our rallies are going up, along with associated costs, e.g., catering. If you can find an



alternative venue other than what has been proposed for the remainder of 2022 and 2023 (see our website at www.gmc49ers.org), review the Rally Host Guidelines for our venue requirements and, if requirements are met, work with the Club President to book said venue(s) and perhaps host the rally. Possibility of dues increases will be discussed at the next business meeting and, since this will be a change to our bylaws, the entire voting membership will be required to vote on the change.

Secretary's Report: Secretary George Beckman reminded members to check our website www.gmc49ers.org frequently for updates. Our website and our newsletters are much more meaningful and interesting when we include photos you take at our rallies, so be sure to send them to George.
