Bacon 'N Egg Brunch — Recipe from Jodell Banovich

3 cups cheddar cheese (or other flavor) small croutons (not plain)

1 cup shredded mild cheddar cheese

8 eggs, beaten

3 c milk

1 tsp dry mustard

1 tsp onion salt (or onion powder)

½ tsp pepper

8 slices crisp-fried bacon, crumbled



Grease 13"x9" pan. Pour croutons and cheese over bottom. In separate bowl beat eggs, milk, mustard, salt and pepper. Mix well and pour over croutons and cheese. Sprinkle crumbled bacon on top. Bake at 325 degrees for 45 minutes, or till eggs are set. Makes 8 good-size servings.
